ITEM TITLE: Discuss and Consider Approval of Resolution 2022-12, A Resolution to Increase the Salary of the Elected Chief of Police of the City of Sallisaw.

BACKGROUND: This resolution will increase the salary of the elected chief of police position for Sallisaw. The last base salary adjustment for the Chief of Police was in August 2007, setting the salary at \$51,500.00. Since 2007, the salary of the Chief has been increased by various COLA increases up to the current salary of \$59,148.61. Taking into consideration the salaries of the police department captains and lieutenants noted below, we recommend setting the salary of the Chief of Police at \$80,000.00. Resolution will be presented at the meeting.

- With recent salary structure changes with police officers, the captains of the department now top out at \$75,702.00
- With recent salary structure changes with police officers, the lieutenants now top out at \$62,252.00 plus overtime.
